## Expanding Our Reach in Loudoun County

With its physical presence established in Purcellville, Blue Ridge Hospice is at a vantage point to offer its comprehensive services to the entire county of Loudoun. To assist in this expansion, the Western Loudoun Advisory Board, about 30 citizen volunteers from both Loudoun and neighboring Clarke County, has transitioned to the Loudoun/Clarke Advisory Board. A number of these dedicated board members were on hand February 29 to cut the ribbon of the newly re-designed Blue Ridge Hospice Thrift Shop, the first of four thrift shops operated by Blue Ridge Hospice.

For more than three years now, Blue Ridge Hospice has been nurturing its presence in the Town of Purcellville (population 6,200 plus), with an eye to expansion in the communities of Loudoun County.

Visibility in this growing community began in earnest when Purcellville was selected as the location for the organization's first thrift shop.

Thanks to the continued efforts of Purcellville Shop Manager Kim Rehm; Coordinator of our four shops, Jacki Mumm, and numerous dedicated volunteers and staff, the Blue Ridge

Hospice Thrift Shop at 151 West Main Street in the heart of downtown Purcellville is prospering. Situated in one of Purcellville's older buildings, once the home of the Lynn family's carpet and flooring business, this large building has been transformed into attractive retail surroundings and office space for members of the Blue Ridge Hospice clinical staff.

Gently-used, brand-name clothing bargains for the entire family are but a fraction of the treasures and opportunities available to the community from this location. Furniture, household items, linens, children's toys, and unique silent auction items are also featured. The community has been generous in its outpouring of quality donations.

The backbone of Blue Ridge Hospice's efforts to create a presence in Loudoun are the volunteer members of the Loudoun/Clarke Advisory Board. This group of 30 Loudoun and Clarke County women residents came together several years ago with

Successfully receiving accreditation is a tribute to our staff at Blue Ridge Hospice for their ongoing commitment to ensuring we meet quality standards and a high level of patient care. This unannounced survey is conducted every three years and looks into every aspect of patient care standards and organizational management. Blue Ridge Hospice successfully met the established standards and regulations in the areas of ethics, rights and responsibilities, provision of care, treatment and services, medication management, prevention and control of infection, and environmental safety and equipment management. The survey also included investigation of information management, human resources management, leadership, and steps toward improving organizational performance.

Our not-for-profit Blue Ridge Hospice is entering its 27th year of serving the counties of Frederick, Clarke, Loudoun, Warren, Shenandoah, Fauquier, Page, and Rappahannock and the city of Winchester. Last year, Blue Ridge Hospice cared for more than 850 patients and assisted more than 2,000 family members through its grief and loss services. With our eight-bed residential hospice facility in downtown Winchester staying at capacity, Blue Ridge Hospice has plans to open a second residential center.

A MESSAGE FROM THE PLANNED GIFTS COMMITTEE

## You Can Give Stock, Too — It's Not That Hard!

Now that tax filing for most people has come to an end, it is a great time to examine what you can do in 2008 to minimize your tax burden. One very easy and worthwhile way to help minimize your taxes is through charitable giving. Most people think of simply writing a check because it is easy to do; however, there are other ways you can make charitable donations.

*Do you have highly appreciated securities that would trigger income tax if you sold them? Have you considered a charitable gift of those securities to Blue Ridge Hospice?*

Highly appreciated securities are securities (generally stocks and mutual funds) that have risen in value since they were acquired. The difference between the current value and the value when acquired is considered built-in capital gain.

Under most circumstances, capital gain is taxable upon the sale of the securities; however, there is one notable exception to the taxation of that gain—*contributing the securities directly to charity.*

If the stock is not appreciated (i.e. it has a built-in loss), the better option is normally to sell the stock, and then contribute the sales proceeds to Blue Ridge Hospice. You can deduct both the capital loss and the charitable contribution; however, you are normally limited in the amount of capital loss you can deduct each year, with any excess being carried forward to future years.

The tax-favored advantage of contributing appreciated securities directly to Blue Ridge Hospice is only effective for stocks and mutual funds. Some bonds may receive favorable treatment; however, you should consult your accountant, attorney, or financial advisor for more details on transferring other types of investments.

It is now quite easy to make planned gifts of what was once thought of as small security positions. A gift of even 5 or 10 shares is very meaningful to Blue Ridge Hospice, whether these are one-time gifts or done annually as part of a planned giving program. You may even want to designate or restrict your gift to fund certain programs or projects.

Should you wish to explore the possibility of making a gift of stock to Blue Ridge Hospice, please contact Anthony Crosen, Director of Development at 540-536-5210. He can provide you with the delivery instructions that will allow your broker/financial advisor to arrange the transfer. If you have actual paper stock certificates in your possession, we can assist you with the paperwork to expeditiously make your gift. Please contact Anthony in advance, so that your gift may be properly identified and you can receive deserved recognition.

Anyone contemplating a transaction of this nature should still consult their accountant, attorney, or financial advisor in order to determine any impact on their personal situation.

### Notable Advantages to Making a Gift of Appreciated Stock Directly to Blue Ridge Hospice

- You may take a charitable deduction for the full fair market value of the stock (including the built-in gain) in one year generally up to 30% of your adjusted gross income.
- A deduction exceeding the income limit may be carried forward for five years to help offset future income.
- You avoid incurring capital gains tax.
- You can fulfill your charitable giving goals while receiving a charitable tax deduction against your current income.
- Transferring stock is fairly easy to do.
- The charitable gift may reduce your taxable estate and diminish future estate tax consequences.

### The Mrs. Smith Example

*Mrs. Smith wanted to show her appreciation for the assistance Blue Ridge Hospice provided during her husband's illness. She has a stock portfolio that she does not use to maintain her lifestyle. After speaking with Blue Ridge Hospice, she decides to donate 100 shares of XYZ Stock, worth \$2,000. She and her husband originally bought the stock in 1980 for \$250. Mrs. Smith's financial advisor helps her transfer the 100 shares of XYZ to Blue Ridge Hospice. Mrs. Smith receives a charitable deduction for the \$2,000 given to Hospice, assuming that her income level supports that size deduction, and she also avoids the capital gain tax liability on \$1,750 that could have occurred if she were to have sold the stock and contributed the proceeds to Blue Ridge Hospice.*

## Program on Patient Care from the Public's Perspective

Hospice educator, author, and speaker, Betsy Murphy, FNP, CHPN, will present a half-day program on Friday, June 6, at Grace Episcopal Church in Berryville. She will focus on caring for individuals in the final months of life from the perspective of the general public. Blue Ridge Hospice will also provide a short presentation on the benefits of pet and music therapies.



Sponsored by The Barns of Rose Hill and Blue Ridge Hospice, the event represents a collaborative effort between the two organizations to benefit the community.

Betsy has worked in hospice care for 23 years in the Washington metropolitan area. Trained as a family nurse practitioner and certified as a hospice and palliative care nurse, she found the field of hospice work of great interest and has devoted her career to improving end-of-life care for patients and their families. In recent years, her focus shifted from hands-on nursing to an educator's role by teaching nurses, social workers, and the general public how to effectively work with patients in their final stages of life.

Widely published in nursing journals and a frequent speaker on hospice care, Betsy was prompted to write her own book, *Guide to Caregiving in the Final Months of Life*, after watching many caregivers struggle to understand how to serve as an advocate for a loved one in the acute care setting.

A resident of the Middleburg area, Betsy was recognized in 1997 and 2003 as an Outstanding Woman of Loudoun by the Loudoun County Board of Supervisors. In 1993, she was honored as an Outstanding Woman in Medicine by the Loudoun County Board of Supervisors.

# Make April 16 (or soon thereafter) Your Healthcare Decisions Day

History will be made April 16, 2008. Approximately 50 of the most prominent national healthcare, religious, and legal associations and organizations as well as countless local and state organizations will participate in the inaugural National Healthcare Decisions Day. At every level, the goal of this nationwide initiative is to ensure that all adults with decision-making capacity in America have both the information and the opportunity to communicate and document their future healthcare decisions.

While making healthcare decisions is often difficult in the best of circumstances, making decisions for others is even more complicated. Each of us has the ability guide our healthcare providers and our loved ones about we want. Advance directives give you the ability to document the types of healthcare you do and do not want and to name an “agent” to speak for you if you cannot speak for yourself. As Terri Schiavo’s situation vividly revealed, having an advance directive can be valuable for all adults, regardless of current age or health status.

With the Patient Self-Determination Act of 1990, Congress affirmed the right of every citizen to set

forth his or her future healthcare wishes in writing with an “advance directive.” Yet, various estimates suggest that fewer than 25% of all Americans have an advance directive. For an action that can be done without a lawyer, for free, and relatively easily, this figure is astonishingly low.

In recognition of this, National Healthcare Decisions Day strives to provide much-needed information to the public, reduce the number of tragedies that occur when a person’s wishes are unknown, and improve the ability of healthcare facilities and providers to offer informed and thoughtful guidance about advance healthcare planning to their patients.

With healthcare, “your decisions matter,” however, others need to know your wishes to honor them. There are no wrong answers when thinking about healthcare choices and completing an advance directive. Please use April 16, 2008, to decide, discuss, and document your wishes, whatever they may be.
